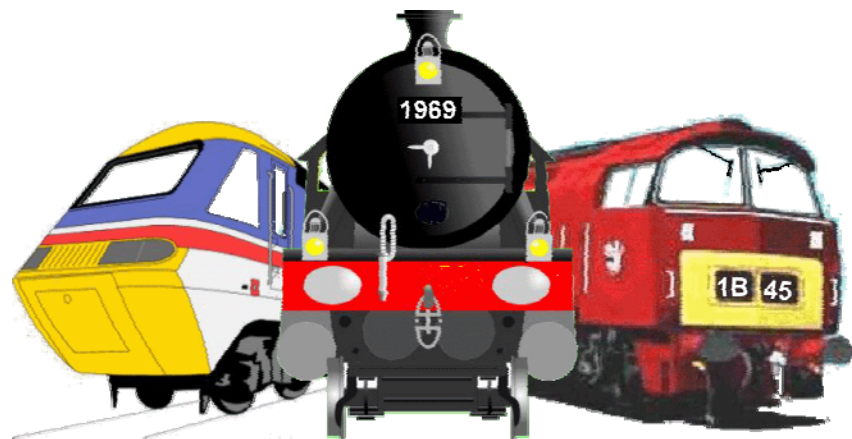
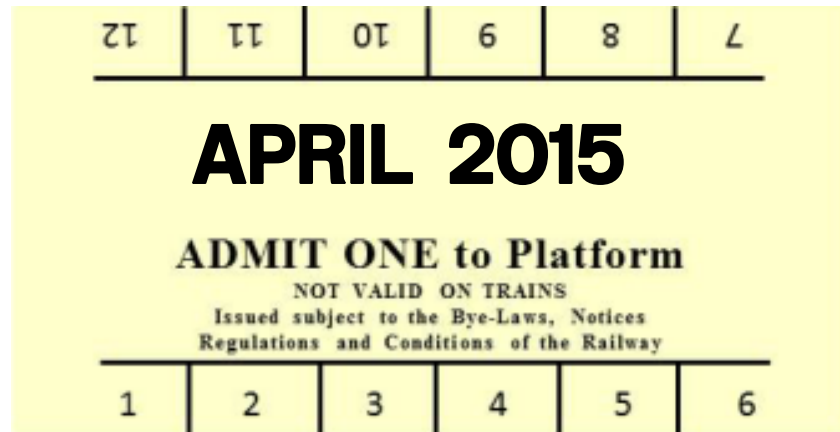

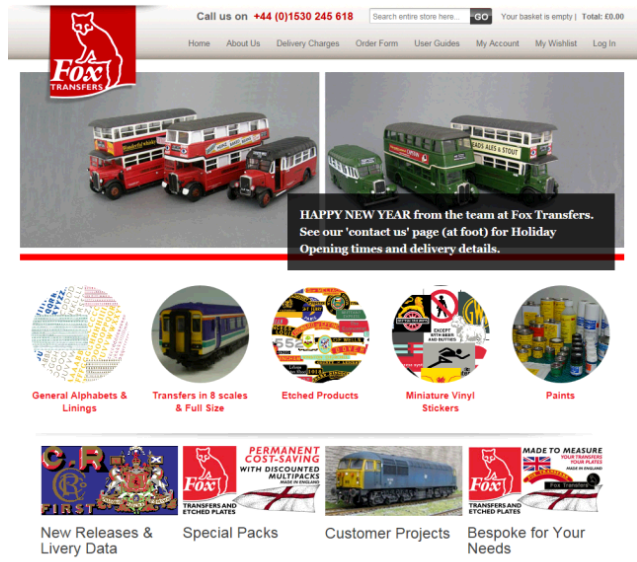
Web Site of the Month

They state it is more useful and much easier to navigate than its predecessors including product pages with more detailed descriptions and images which can be enlarged to view better the sheet content.

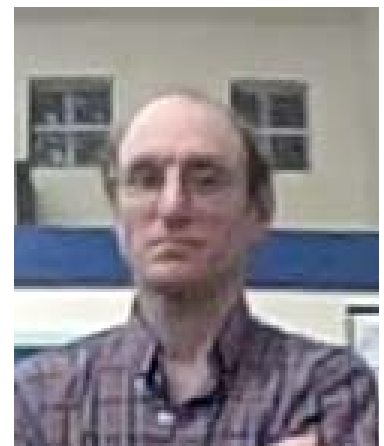
They will be adding more information over a period of time to assist buyers in selecting the correct items for their requirements, including adding livery data sheets for your reference.

The Treasurers Gripe

Club Accounting Procedure - Claims & Submissions

There has been a habit of late creeping into the Club whereby Club members claiming expenses and/or paying in funds are doing their own thing. They probably think by using their initiative they are helping the treasurer; but in fact the opposite is the case.

I'm not going into details of the latest incident, but below I will state the procedure that is to be adhered to from now on .

- 1) Any member submitting a claim will give the invoice/ receipt to the treasurer. All claims must have supporting documentation. The treasurer will on receipt of the claim arrange reimbursement.
- 2) Any members paying funds into the Club (cash or cheque) from the sale of Club stock or commission on the sale of personal stock etc must go through our Sales Officer—John Walker. John will then liaise with the treasurer.
- 3) Any other financial transactions e.g. donations, deposits (for goods or services) will be dealt with by the treasurer.

If you have a situation whereby for example you wish to submit items under sections 1 and 2 above, simultaneously, then please keep them separate— claims relating to 1) go to the treasurer and submissions relating to 2) go to John. Maintaining the Clubs accounts is an involved job as it is with unnecessary complications being created.
